I will abide by the Bozeman Fire Department Ride Along Policy and will wear my seatbelt at all times while riding in the fire truck. This release and waiver applies to my heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns. I agree to adhere to the dress code which is as follows:

Dress code will be shirt, pants, and jacket or clothing appropriate to the season. Blue jeans, shorts, tennis shoes, sneakers, or sandals are **not** allowed. No insignia or other agency name will appear on clothing.
