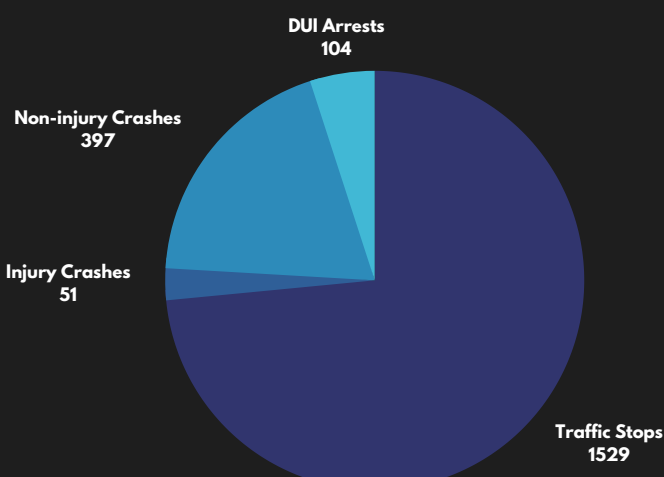
### CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS



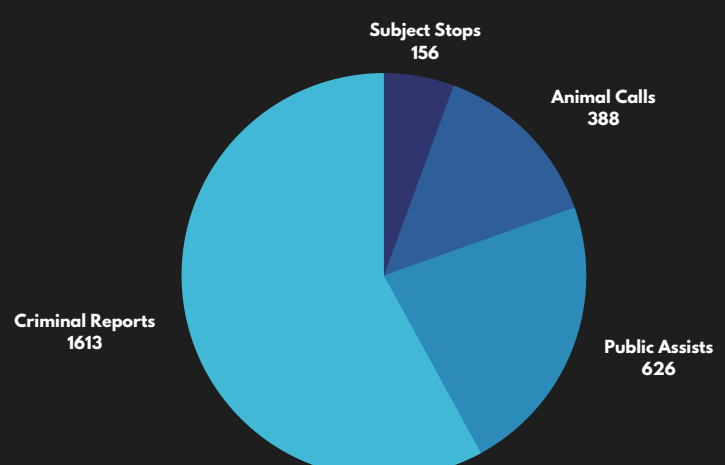

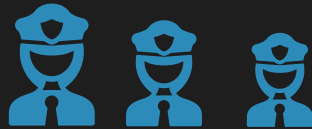
