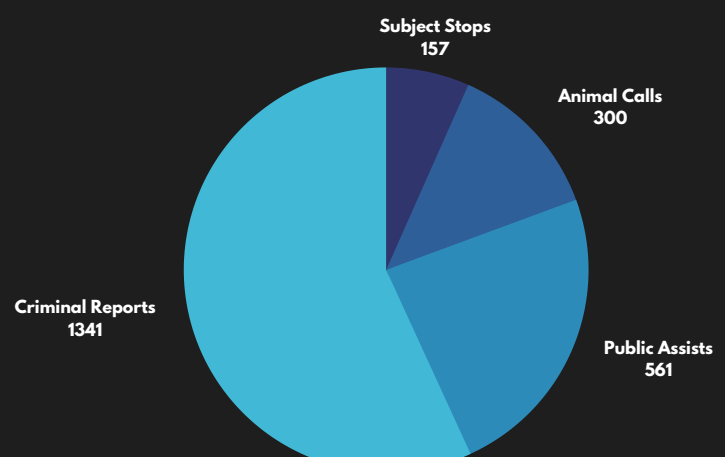

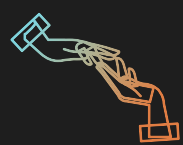
Business Relationships
