POOL RULES – MT HEALTH CODE ARM 37.115.1402

The main drains must be clearly visible and sharply defined from any point on the side of the pool. Anything else requires the management to close the pool.

Take a cleansing shower before using the pool.

Please do not use the pool if you have had diarrhea or any other disease transmittable by the water in the past two weeks.

Swimmers who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper with waterproof pants and elastic openings for the legs and waist.

Do not change diapers near or on the deck.

Do not bring food, drink, gum or tobacco into the pool or onto the deck area.

No animals in the pool or deck area except as required under the American with Disabilities Act.

Offensive or unsanitary behavior is prohibited.

Non-swimmers and children under the age of 14 shall not use the pool without a responsible adults in attendance. Adults must be 18 or older.

Bozeman Municipal Code

Sec. 24.03.010. – Interfering with public officials prohibited.

No person shall interfere with, obstruct or intimidate any official or employee of the city in the performance of the official's or employee's duty; nor shall any person assault or threaten to assault, nor use any abusive or insulting language toward such official or employee in the official's or employee's presence in connection with or arising out of any business of the city theretofore, then being, or thereafter to be done, transacted or performed by such official or employees for, and as representative of the city, in any capacity.

State Law Reference – Obstructing peace office or other public servant, MCA 45-7-302.

Sec.24.04.140. – Offensive conduct; where prohibited.

No person shall act in a loud, boisterous or rude manner, or engage in conduct so as to be offensive to those using or being upon or within any of the public parks, or grounds of the city, or within the fairgrounds or roundup grounds in the city.
