- b) Agrees not to let water run to waste.
- c) If exemption request is approved, agrees to post the exemption or relaxation permit in view of the public (not applicable for private residences).
- d) Agrees that exemptions are only in effect for one growing season (May 1st to October 1st of the same year) and will need to be resubmitted every year.
- e) Agrees that the exemption may be withdrawn at any time due to changes in drought conditions or for any reason deemed necessary by the Director.

By affixing their signature below, the Applicant affirms that all statements and documentation provided with this Application are true, correct, in compliance with the Outdoor Water Use Restrictions Manual, and understands that failure to comply with all applicable requirements of Chapter 40 of the Bozeman Municipal Code, and any specific conditions of exemption or relaxation approval placed by the City is sufficient cause for the city to revoke the Applicant's exemption or relaxation. Applicant further understands and agrees that this exemption or relaxation may be superseded by any watering restrictions effective during an official City drought declaration.

Applicant agrees to hold harmless the City of Bozeman, its contractors, agents, officers, employees, and directors from any claim made by any person for injuries, property damage, loss, or liability as a result of, or in any way connected to approved exemptions or relaxations resulting from this application.
