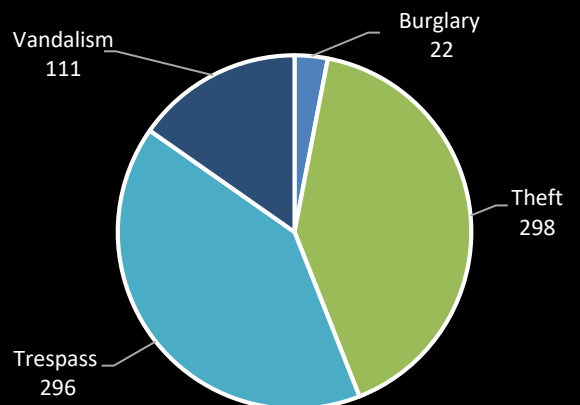

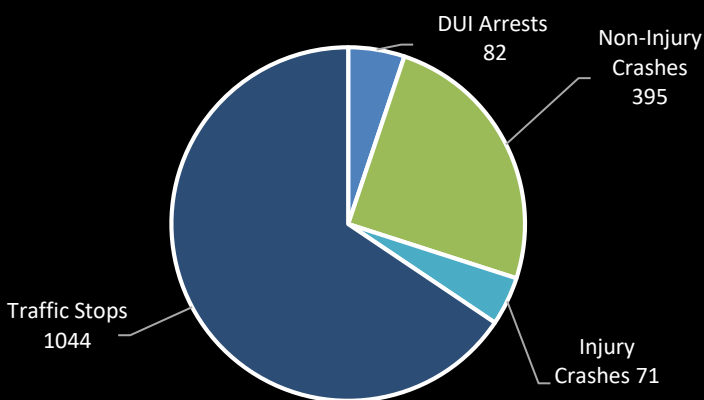
CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS



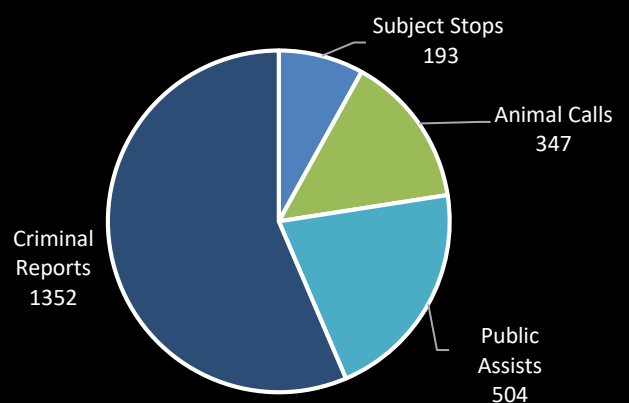
PROPERTY CRIMES
